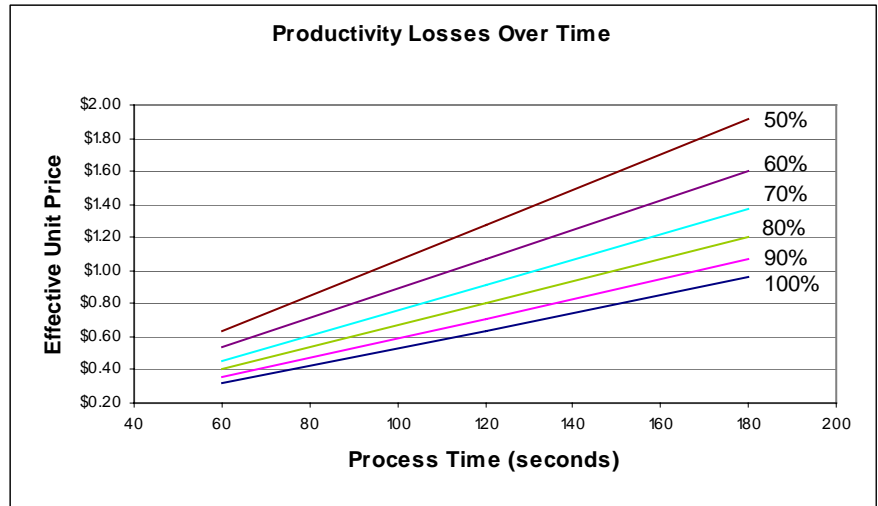

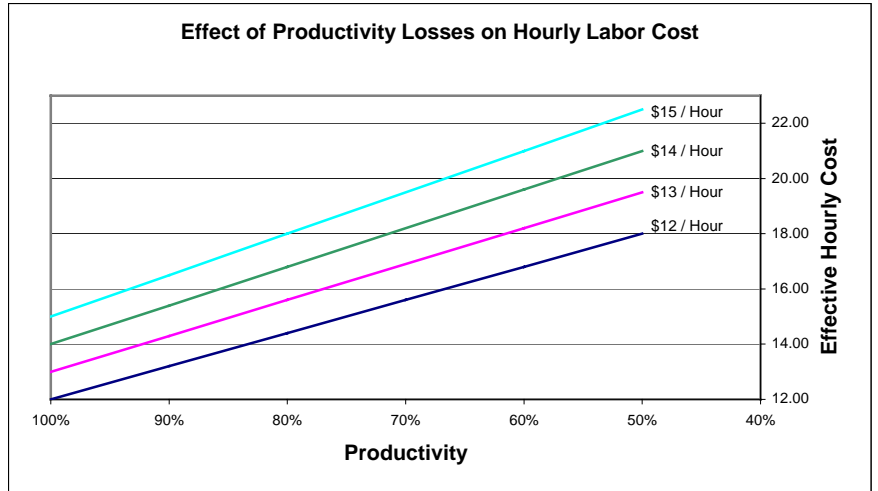
Productivity Losses Over Time

- Reduced productivity has the effect of increased price per unit.
- Longer processing times amplify the effect of reduced productivity, resulting in greater labor costs.
- ASAP's fixed unit price ensures your margins will not be eroded by productivity losses.



Effect of Productivity Losses on Hourly Labor Cost

- Productivity losses have the effect of increasing the hourly cost of an employee.
- Calculating labor costs based on a flat rate temporary employee assumes companies are paying for 100% productivity.
- Overhead costs to achieve the desired productivity from temporary staffing is typically not considered in cost models.
- ASAP's fixed unit price eliminates variable hourly rates and overhead required to maintain productivity.
